

Road Trip Virtual Block of the Month

Block 11 – Georgia Square

10 ½” unfinished block



Fabric Cutting

Fabric A – Squares and rectangle units

Cut 12 ea 2 ½” squares

Fabric B - Squares and ½ square triangles

Cut 4 ea 2 ½” squares

Cut 2 ea 2 7/8” squares

Fabric C – Squares and ½ square triangles

Cut 2 ea 2 7/8” squares

Cut 1 ea 2 ½” squares

Cut 4 ea 2 ½” x 6 ½” rectangles

Block Assembly

1. Half Square Triangles – use the 2 7/8” squares to create the ½ square triangles. Right sides together, take 1 Fabric B 2 7/8” square & 1 Fabric C 2 7/8” square – Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other; sew ¼” on each side of the line; cut on the drawn line to create 2 ½ square triangles; square to a 2 ½” blocks. Repeat with the other remaining 2 7/8” square to create 4 2 ½” blocks
2. Rectangle Units – Take 2 Fabric A 2 ½” squares and draw a line corner to corner on each square. Place the squares on each end of a Fabric C rectangle – right sides together. Sew on the diagonal line and cut off the excess seam allowance. Press toward the corner. Repeat for a total of 4 rectangle units. Refer to diagram A for placement of diagonal line.
3. Refer to the diagram to create the 9 patch center block using Fabrics A, B and C 2 ½” squares.
4. Refer to the diagram for placement of the 4 ½ square triangles and 4 rectangle units.
