

# Road Trip Virtual Block of the Month

## Block 10 – Baton Rouge Square

10 ½” unfinished block



### Fabric Cutting

Fabric A – Squares and ½ square triangles

Cut 4 ea 2 7/8” squares

Cut 8 ea 2 ½” squares

Fabric B - Squares

Cut 5 ea 2 ½” squares

Fabric C – Squares and ½ square triangles

Cut 4 ea 2 7/8” squares

Cut 4 ea 2 ½” squares

### Block Assembly

1. Half Square Triangles – use the 2 7/8” squares to create the ½ square triangles. Right sides together, take 1 Fabric A 2 7/8” square & 1 Fabric C 2 7/8” square – Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other; sew ¼” on each side of the line; cut on the drawn line to create ½ square triangle; square to a 2 ½” blocks. Repeat with the remaining 2 7/8” squares to create 8 ea 2 ½” blocks
2. Refer to the diagram to create the 4 corner sections of the block using the ½ square triangle blocks that you have just made and Fabric A 2 ½” squares.
3. Refer to the diagram to assemble the 2 ½” square units from Fabric B and Fabric C.

Follow the block diagram for placement – layout pieces before sewing
