

Road Trip Virtual Block of the Month

Block 12 – Star Lane - Florida

10 ½” unfinished block



Fabric Cutting

Fabric A – Squares and rectangle units

Cut 8 ea 2 ½” squares

Cut 8 ea 1 ½’ X 2 ½” rectangles

Cut 4 ea 1 ½” x 4 ½” rectangles

Fabric B - Squares and ½ square triangles

Cut 4 ea 1 ½” squares

Cut 2 ea 2 7/8” squares

Fabric C – Squares and ½ square triangles

Cut 2 ea 2 7/8” squares

Cut 4 ea 2 ½” squares

Cut 4 ea 2 ½” x 4 ½” rectangles

Block Assembly

1. Half Square Triangles – use the 2ea 2 7/8” squares to create the ½ square triangles for the center block. Right sides together, take 1 Fabric B square & 1 Fabric C square – Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other; sew ¼” on each side of the line; cut on the drawn line to create 2 ½” square triangles; square to 2 ½” blocks. Create 4 ea 2 ½” blocks – refer to the diagram to create the pin wheel center block (4 ½ “ unfinished)
2. Rectangle Units – Take 2 Fabric A 2 ½” squares and draw a line corner to corner on each square. Place the squares on each end of a Fabric C rectangle – right sides together. Sew on the diagonal line and cut off the excess seam allowance. Press toward the corner. Repeat for a total of 4 rectangle units. Refer to diagram A for placement of diagonal line.
3. Refer to the diagram to assemble each of the block rows and to connect all the rows.
