

# Road Trip Virtual Block of the Month

## Block 5 – Dakota Gold

10 ½” unfinished block



### Fabric Cutting

Color A	Cut 5 ea 2 ½” squares Cut 4 ea 3” squares
Color B	Cut 2 ea 2 ½” x 4 ½” rectangles Cut 4 ea 3” squares
Color C	Cut 2 ea 2 ½” x 4 ½” rectangles Cut 4 ea 3” squares

### Block Assembly

1. Create ½ square triangle units by combining the 3” x 3” squares as follows:

A + B Squares – 2 units

A + C Squares – 2 units

B + C Squares – 2 units

Place the unit squares right side together and draw a line corner to corner; sew ¼” on each side of the line; cut on line; square the ½ triangle block to a 2 ½” square

2. Create the corner 4-block units by combining 3 ea 2 ½” triangle blocks and 1 ea 2 ½” square as shown in the drawing below. (4 ½” square)
3. Attach these blocks to the C rectangles – see drawing below.
4. Attach the B rectangles to the A 2 ½” square as shown in the drawing.
5. Sew the 3 rows together.
