

Road Trip Virtual Block of the Month

Block 8 – Alpine Cross

10 ½” unfinished block



Fabric Cutting

Fabric A - Square & half/square triangles (Light)

Cut 2 3” squares

Cut 1 ea 2 ½” square

Fabric B - ½ square triangles (Medium)

Cut 8 ea 3” squares

Fabric C - Rectangles & ½ square triangles (Dark)

Cut 4 2 ½ x 4 ½” rectangles

Cut 6 3” squares

Block Assembly

- Half square triangles:
 - With right sides together – using 2 3” squares from Fabric A and 2 3” squares from Fabric B - Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other; sew ¼ in on each side of the line; cut on the drawn line to create ½ square triangles; square to a 2 ½” block.
 - With right sides together – using 6 Fabric B and Fabric C 3” squares - Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other; sew ¼ in on each side of the line; cut on the drawn line to create ½ square triangles; square to a 2 ½” block.
- Refer to the diagram below for placement of the ½ square triangles.
- Sew the 4 corner block sections (using the ½ square triangles)
- Sew the 3 individual rows together - Press the top and bottom row seams to the center rectangle. Press the middle row seams to the outside rectangle.
- Sew the 3 rows together to form the block.
